#### Tickets reminder



# **Advanced Friday Night Clinic**

An advanced clinic for good parallel skiers (e.g. can do 5 short radius turns on the green matting) who are looking to improve their personal skiing will start on 9th January at 8pm. The clinic plans to cover topics such as carving, drills and exercises for bumps/mogul skiing, developing short radius turns, timing and rhythm and any other topics as agreed by the class. Friday nights tend to be quieter than other nights so often there is a freer slope to work with.





### **SCI Race Squad Update**

<u>Development Squad</u> - As the enthusiasm for race training continues to grow we've seen an increase in the size of the newly formed Development Squad run by Tony McGuinness. Testament to the appeal of Tony as a coach - every week brings a new applicant. The squad has grown to such an extent that we plan to break it out to two sub-squads, Junior and Children.



<u>Children's Race Squad</u> - A successful October mid-term camp was run in Tignes and included a large number of our Children racers training on snow for the first time. The camp proved an excellent introduction to training/racing on snow and leads nicely into the upcoming Christmas camp in Austria.

<u>Junior Race Squad</u> - Some members of the Junior squad also trained in Tignes. This included all of the European Youth Olympic squad who have also recently returned from a race camp in Norway where they completed 7 races with some excellent results. Most notable being Simon Lyons scoring 148 FIS points in his second ever race.

<u>Borrufa</u> - The team to compete at the Borrufa Children's competition in Andorra was announced and includes a squad of 8 racers - this is the maximum we are allowed under competition rules and is the biggest team we have ever had compete. The team includes: Hubert Gallagher, Lauren O'Riordan, Stephen Power, Sean Murray, Iain Gallagher, Kieran McNamara, Emer Pisarnik and Meadbh Byrne.

Upcoming events include the following - League Race on 7th December, Race camp in Italy early December, SES Cup in Italy mid December, Training Camp in Austria late December/early January.

#### **Pre-Teen Class**

A pre-teen class for children aged from 8 to 12 has started on Sunday mornings. The class runs from 12.30 - 14.00 to coincide with Kindergarten classes. It caters for children who are comfortable skiing from the top station on the main slope.
